

Putting up a Tentipi adventure tent indoors and make it look nice could be a little tricky. This exhibition frame makes it a lot easier. Tentipi provides a kit containing;

- 8 metal corner fittings 16 screws 16 threaded inserts
 You will also need;
- 8 weights, approx. 5 kg each 8 planks, 22 x 95 mm (length as below)

Preparing the planks

Plank dimension 22 x 95 mm End angle 22,5°

Length of plank:

Tent size 5: 129 cm

Tent size 7: 148 cm
Tent size 9: 183 cm




Prepare the planks by cutting the ends in a 22,5 degree angle. Drill a hole, 60 mm from both ends. Screw in a threaded insert from the underside of the plank.

First put the screws losely in their right position.



Measure across the frame and make sure it's symmetrical.



Tighten the screws.

Place wheigts on the corners and raise the nordic tipi.
