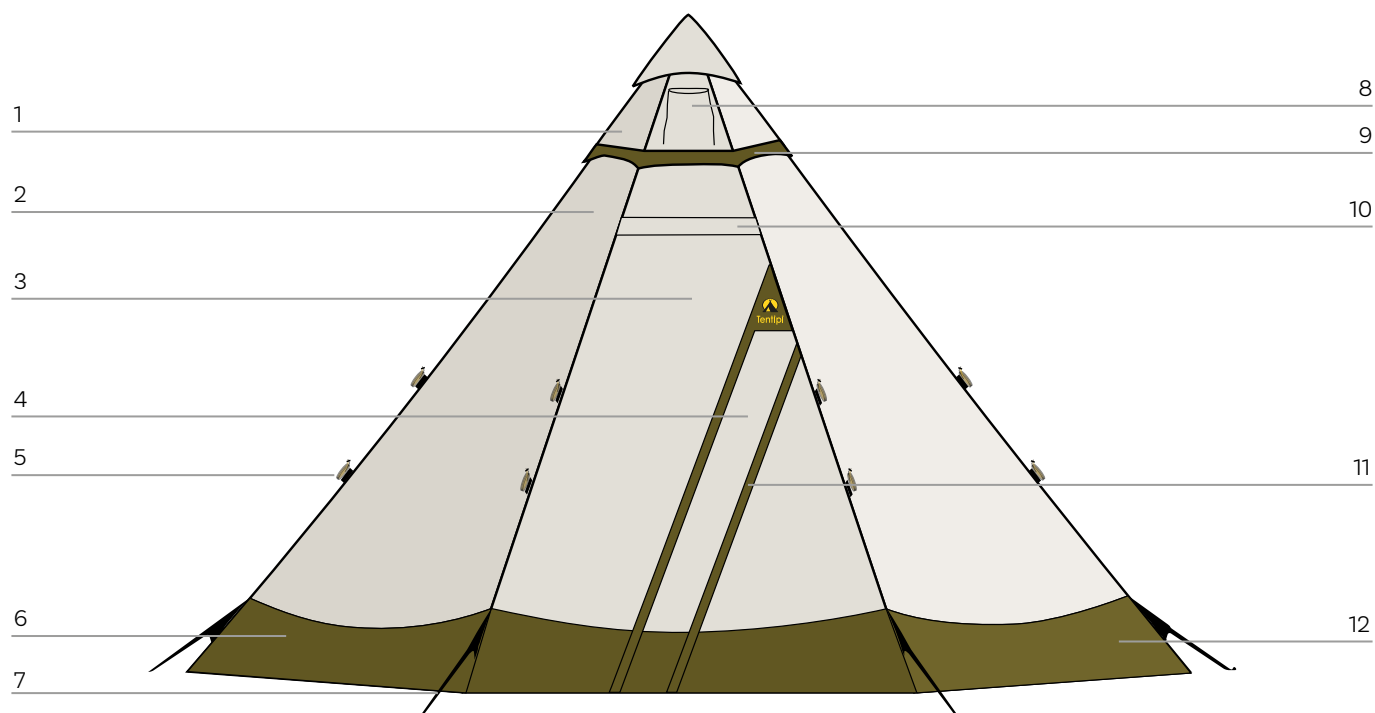

Key features



1

Large smoke opening with integrated mosquito net

Ensures efficient ventilation on warm days and smoke clearance when using a fire.

2

Tent fabric

Very strong and sustainable fabric. Unique blend of hemp, organic cotton and recycled polyester.

3

Central pole

Five-piece hardened aluminium alloy pole.

4

Door fitted with mosquito net

Improves ventilation. Diagonal zip with rain flap prevents water penetration.

5

Storm cords and fastenings

Facilitate even distribution of strain on the tent walls. Storm cord holders allow cords to be in place ready for use, without tangling.

6

Reinforced edging

50 centimetres high, for better wear resistance. Exposed parts of the tent walls are strengthened with strain-relief reinforcements.

7

Ground straps

Strong, adjustable ground straps are used instead of cords to tension the Nordic tipi.

8

Chimney opening

Versatile feature that allows the easy fitting of a stove.

9

In-Tent vent™ system

Allows maximum control of the tent's indoor climate using patented technology.

10

Accessory sleeve

Built-in feature for attaching porch or canopy.

11

Safety toggles

Enable door to be closed even if the zip has been damaged.

12

Three large air intakes

Adjustable from inside the tent, each fitted with a mosquito net.



Fabric – Environmex Pro

Safir eco; made from a unique blend of hemp, organic cotton and recycled polyester. The results of testing in harsh conditions demonstrate exclusive features; robust strength, highly UV resistant, excellent stability and high water-repellent properties. The combination of these features produces a well-ventilated and premium “indoor” climate. 100 percent eco. Approximately 285 g/m².

Hemp

Hemp is known as one of the strongest natural fibres in the world. It has the same breathable and moisture regulating properties as cotton, but requires very little water for growth or during the production process.

The plant has natural antibacterial characteristics so there is no need for pesticides or other harsh chemicals. Hemp produces a high harvest per square metre. The hemp plant benefits from a deep root system which binds the soil and leaves it in excellent condition for any succeeding crop.

Organic cotton

100 percent biologically grown using less water than conventional cotton, without the use of toxic chemicals.

Recycled polyester

The hemp fabric is reinforced with a recycled polyester, made from renewable plastic bottles. Increased durability with a lower negative impact on the environment.

Original colour (off-white)

The use of non-coloured fabric reduces the carbon footprint. No bleaching chemicals, no fabric dye and less water to purify before being discharged into wastewater networks.

Double ventilator cap fitted with net, three air intakes with net, door with net, mosquito-net ceiling, central pole, storm cords, storm cord holders, measuring tape, two inside pockets, compression bag and advanced tent pegs.
